We will look at poems, stories and a English range of non fiction texts. The children will be encouraged to write for length, sequence their ideas and include capital letters and full stops. We will continue to strengthen out spelling and grammar skills. This term children will be continuing their work on counting and place value to 100. They will also be Maths looking at multiplication and division (for example arrays), fractions (including halves and quarters), investigating money and telling the time (half past and quarter past the hour). Our cool topic is Fantastic Beats! We will explore a range of fictional and real beasts. The children will have lots of first hand experiences from having duckling to looking for mini beasts at Weston Park. Topic We will complete our work on animals including humans, learning about the human skeleton and Science comparing it to animal skeletons. We will also be finding out about the characteristics of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Religious We will be looking at how babies are welcomed after they are born. The children will be comparing how Education the Christian, Islamic and Sikh faiths prepare for a naming ceremony. Music will be taught by Mrs Gullick, and will be linked to our topic. Children will learn simple songs and Music have the opportunity to play simple rhythms on percussion instruments.
